The positions may require international travel and all applicants must hold a full valid passport. Appointment will be made subject to a DBS check.

Purpose of the Role

- To act as media manager for Wales Women and Girls Rugby League.
- To be part of an exciting media team, reporting to the Communications Manager.
- To be part of an exciting women's pathway in Wales, reporting to the Head of Women's Rugby League in Wales and the Wales Women National Side Head Coach.

Principal Duties and Activities

- To report on major women's events in Wales, including Cardiff Demons matches in the Women's Super League South.
- Participate in media manager meetings.
- Promote, wherever possible, the profile of Wales Rugby League and the game of Rugby League as a whole.
- Avail yourself to the WRL at such specific times and at such specific locations as the parties shall mutually agree to.

Essential Experience and Specialist Knowledge

- Experience in media work, be it in college, university or during their working life, especially content writing.
- A knowledge of sport is essential.
- Applicants must be able to prove that they can cope with tight deadlines as match reporting live from the ground will be inevitable.
- Extensive knowledge of social media, including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and Tiktok.



Desirable Knowledge

- A good working knowledge of IT including ability to work with common Microsoft packages.
- Some knowledge of the Welsh language is preferred.
